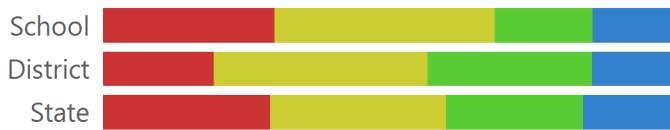

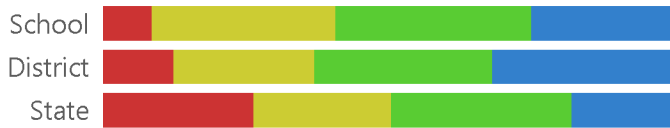

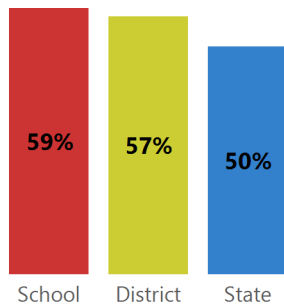

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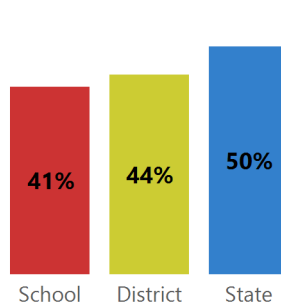
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## Student Achievement Progress Scores

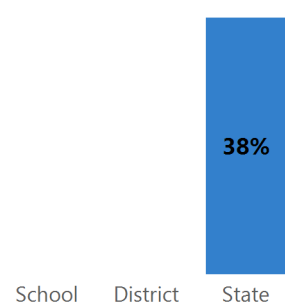
% of students showing progress in Reading

% of English Learners showing progress toward English proficiency

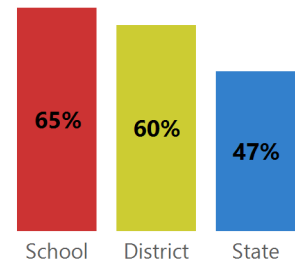
